We are led by BIPOC members, working collectively to align and amplify our time, talent, and treasure to address complex social change in Asheville and Western North Carolina. The infrastructure created by CoThinkk has been in action since 2014 centering structural change and equity in order to shift the narrative and disparities of BIPOC communities in Western North Carolina. With a network of over 75 members, BIPOC grantee partners, leadership awardees, and solidarity change agents - working deeply in the community - we support change through four (4) strategic pathways: (1) healing together, (2) access to resources (internally and externally), (3) capacity-building, and (4) systems change towards achieving long-term impact.



This multi-faceted approach is anchored deeply in community-driven and emergent practices that enables our network to intentionally create space to constantly work towards shifting the six conditions of systems change through building awareness and analysis, while concurrently aligning our actions and ensuring accountability to community. This focus allows for a great deal of nimbleness to seed important leadership, relationships, capacity and infrastructure and continue to support an ecosystem of change -in very deep manner- by creating space for innovation and investment.
